### Instructions on using an Android based device with the Overdrive service

There are two paths to download an eBook to an Android device, one is via the Overdrive Media Console and the other is with the Kindle Reading App

#### Overdrive Media Console Method

##### *Downloading the Overdrive Media Console*

- Download the Overdrive Media Console to your device by tapping the **Market** icon (icon with the little green robot)
- Tap on the **magnifying glass** to search the Android Marketplace for the Overdrive Media Console. Tap the Overdrive Media Console to select.
- Tap **Install**
- Tap **Accept and Download**, this may take a few moments.
- Tap **Open**, to complete installation.

##### *Setting a default library on the Overdrive Media Console*



- From the Overdrive Media Console tap the menu icon on the lower or upper borders of the screen and tap on **Get Books**
- The first time you download you will need to find your library, tap on **Add a Library**, tap into the search box (again the keyboard will appear on the bottom of the screen), search for your library by either zip-code or city name, tap search.
- Select your library from the list by tapping on the name.
- To save your library as a default, tap on the star, in front of the name of the library.

##### *Downloading an eBook*

- Tap on the **Overdrive Media Console** icon on your device
- Once the program opens up, tap on the menu icon and tap on **Get Books**
- Select the library location that you saved earlier by tapping on it
- Complete action using the browser, the [tds.lib.overdrive.com](http://tds.lib.overdrive.com) website displays
- Search the website by tapping on the search button on the website or select the browse button on the website.

- Once you found an eBook to check out, tap on **Place in Cart** on the **EPUB** line (or tap in Place Hold, you will be notified via e-mail when the title is available for download)
- Tap on **Proceed to Checkout**
- Tap into the box for your **library card number** and type in your number, excluding the spaces
- Slide the screen up a little, tap into the **password** box and type in your password (provided to you by your local library)
- Slide the screen up again and tap on **Login** (you can either choose to remember password or not to)
- Tap **Confirm check out**
- Tap on **Download** below the title icon
- The title downloads to the Overdrive Media Console, tap on the title to open.

### *Authorizing the Overdrive Media Console with Adobe Digital Editions*

- If you already have an Adobe Digital Edition ID, click on **Settings**, if you do not have an ID tap on **Get ID**
- Tap on **Settings**
- Tap into the box for Adobe ID, usually your e-mail that you used to register at Adobe.com
- Slide up a little and type into the box with your Adobe Digital Edition's ID **password**
- Slide up again and tap on **Authorize**
- This step does NOT need to be repeated again

## **Kindle Reader App Method**

### *Downloading the Amazon Kindle Reader App*

- Download the Amazon Kindle Reader App to your device by tapping on the icon for the **Android Market** (icon with the little green man)
- Tap on the **magnifying glass** to search the Android Marketplace, the keyboard will display at the bottom of the screen. To search, type Amazon Kindle App and next select the Amazon Kindle App by tapping on the icon for the Amazon Kindle App.
- Tap **Install**
- Tap **Accept and Download**, this may take a little while.
- Tap **Open**, you now installed the Amazon Kindle Reader App on your device.
- You are prompted to register with Amazon before using the Amazon Kindle App. Tap into the box for e-mail address and type in your e-mail address associated with your Amazon Account.
- Tap on the password box and enter your password, tap on **Register**.

### *Downloading ebooks from Overdrive to the Kindle App on the Android device*

- Open your Internet Browser on your device and go to [tds.lib.overdrive.com](http://tds.lib.overdrive.com)
- Search the website by tapping on the search button on the website or select the browse button on the website.
- Once you found an eBook to check out, tap on **Place in Cart** on the **Kindle** line (or tap in Place Hold, you will be notified via e-mail when the title is available for download)

- Tap on **Proceed to Checkout**
- Tap into the box for your **library card number** and type in your number, excluding the spaces
- Slide the screen up a little, tap into the **password** box and type in your password (provided to you by your local library)
- Slide the screen up again and tap on **Login** (you can either choose to remember password or not to)
- Tap **Confirm check out**
- Tap on **Get for Kindle** below the title icon, this opens up the Amazon.com webpage (be sure that on the webpage you are logged into the same account as you registered the Amazon Kindle App.
- On Amazon's webpage click on **Get Library Book**, make sure that the book will be delivered to your device. If multiple devices are registered on one account, tap on deliver to and select appropriate device, then tap Get Library Book.
- Go back by tapping to your Home button, select the Amazon Kindle Reader App, along the top, tap the **menu icon** and select **Sync & Check for Items**. The book should now appear in your reading list.
- Tap on the book cover to open book.
