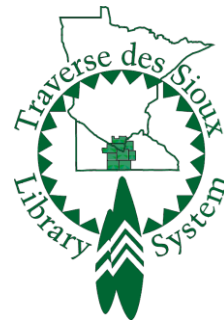


Traverse des Sioux Library System:

Instructions for

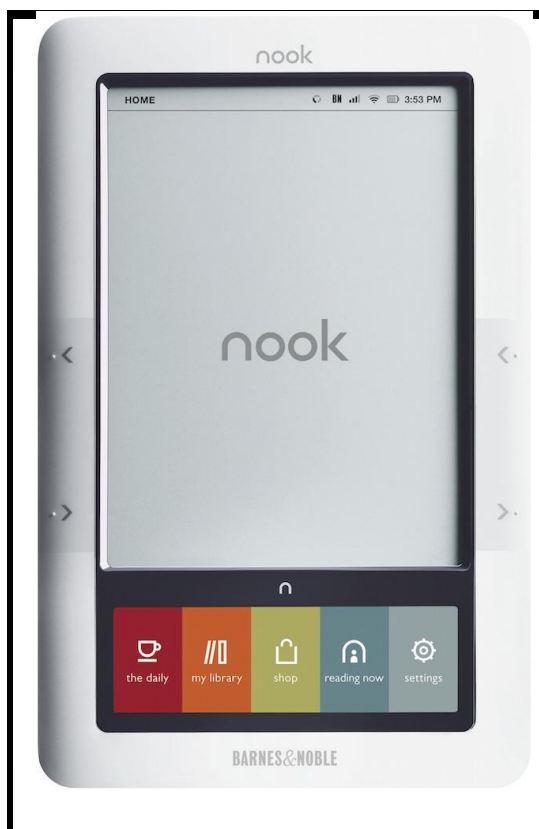
For a Windows-XP PC and a color Nook



Initial Software Setup and Authorizations

1. You'll need to have a library card from a Traverse des Sioux member library.
2. Before you can download library books to your Nook, you will need to install Adobe Digital Editions (ADE) software on your computer. Here are two ways to access this software:
Go to <http://www.adobe.com/products/digitaleditions/> and follow the instructions.
Go to <http://tds.lib.overdrive.com/>. Click on *Adobe Digital Editions* link found on the left side.
3. Open Adobe Digital Editions (i.e. ADE). You will be prompted to create an Adobe account and then to authorize your computer as one of your five devices. Note: You **MUST** create an account or you will not be able to transfer Overdrive eBooks from your computer to your nook. You cannot download Overdrive eBooks directly to your Nook, but must transfer ebooks using Adobe Digital Editions.
4. With Adobe Digital Editions (ADE) open, turn on your Nook and attach it to your computer via the USB port. You will be prompted to authorize your Nook. Follow the click through path to authorize the device. If you do not get this prompt, disconnect the Nook from your PC try a different USB port.

(Note: On your PC, the Nook will show up if Adobe Digital Editions (ADE) is already open, but might not show up if you connected the Nook first.)



Searching for and downloading eBook titles

1. Open Adobe Digital Editions (ADE) software, turn on your Nook, and then plug it into the USB port of your PC.
2. Open your internet browser to <http://tds.lib.overdrive.com>. Search for titles in the following ways: Entering title or keywords in the search bar; browse by format; browse by subject. E-book titles will appear with a format indicator of PDF or EPUB.
3. When you have found a title you want, select *Add to my digital cart*. If the title is already checked out, you may request it by selecting *Place a hold*.
4. After you have added an available title to your cart, select *Proceed to Check out*. When prompted, login by entering your library card number and password. (Ebooks have a 14-day checkout.) Select *Confirm Check out*.
5. Now download the title using the "Download" button under the item. When asked "Do you want to open or save this file" select *Open*. The title will open automatically in Adobe Digital Editions.

(Note: If it doesn't automatically open, locate the downloaded file, which ends in ".acsm", double-click and select Adobe Digital Editions as the application to open.)

Transferring an eBook to your nook

1. In Adobe Digital Editions, click on the *Library View* (the icon of bookshelves upper left). Titles you have downloaded are listed on the right. If you have a lot of titles, you may click on *Borrowed Items*. Drag and drop the title you would like to transfer onto the Nook icon below the Bookshelves.

(Note: If you do not see the Nook icon, your PC and Adobe Digital Editions have not recognized that your e-reader is plugged into the USB port. Did you first open Adobe Digital Editions and turn on your Nook before plugging it into the USB port? If not try again in the correct sequence.)

2. The title is now transferred to the device. On the PC, click *Safely Remove Hardware* icon on the lower right corner of your screen. Then click the *Safely Remove USB Mass Storage Device* box. When you see “Safe to Remove Hardware”, you may detach the nook from your computer.
3. Unlock your Nook by sliding the Nook icon on the touch screen to the right. Tap the menu icon at the bottom of the touch screen and select *Library*. Then select *My files*. Look in the *Digital Editions* folder for your downloaded title. Tap item to begin reading.

(Note: The book jacket of the title does not appear, nor does the downloaded title appear under *Books*, where purchased titles reside.)

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
